

We asked some customers what they think about their I. H. Rissler Round Bale Unroller.....

Love it! Have recommended it to my friends as round bales are the only way to go when you farm by yourself. Since we've gone to feeding baleage our forage has better quality, the cows production has risen, fewer health issues and less time spent feeding, Love it!

We have anywhere from 600 to 2000 hours of use on our five Rissler bale unrollers and they still run like new. We feed 1800 bales yearly to 200 cattle. Rissler bale unrollers cut our feeding time in half, cut the hard work, and increased our milk production. That's money in our pocket. We recommend buying a Rissler round bale unroller.

Feeding 40 head in NY

We have unrolled over 2,000 silage bales since purchasing our Rissler 444 bale unroller 2½ years ago. Its maneuverability, ease of operation, easy maintenance, and simplicity are unmatched. This unroller is a must for anyone with a tie stall barn feeding round bales.

Feeding 200 head in NY

The Rissler round bale unroller is one of the most important pieces of equipment we own now. Trouble free, very efficient, and eliminates a lot of waste. We purchased this machine approximately 3 years ago. I rate the Rissler round bale unroller A+!

Feeding 80 head in NH

Feeding 51 head in PA

Feeding 90 head in NY

In 2009 I purchased a Ferris Z-turn mower, a Polaris Ranger, and a Rissler round bale unroller. The Rissler bale unroller is by far my most important piece of equipment. After pulling and unrolling bales by hand using a 4 wheeled pull cart turntable for 7 years, the Rissler unroller made life so much easier in the barn!

Feeding 100 head in NY

We like our Rissler bale unroller very much! It saves a lot of time. When we had the old bale wagon no one wanted to give baleage to the cows, but now the boys do it alone(and willingly, too). We use it at least once a day, and sometimes twice per day. We would recommend a Rissler round bale unroller because it saves so much time and it is a lot neater than the old way.

Feeding 50 head in PA

We always had a round baler to make hay for our heifers - Never imagined being able to feed round bales in our tie-stall dairy barn. Our Rissler round bale unroller has allowed extra family time on our farm. Feeding hay has become an enjoyment.

Feeding 56 head in NY

I own a 75 cow tie stall dairy in Scipio Center NY. Baleage is my only forage source. I purchased my first Rissler round bale unroller in 2001 and it has fed around 10,000 to 12,000 bales. My second 444 unroller was purchased in 2010. Butterfat is at 3.9%, conception rates high, and herd health is excellent. I could not farm without my 2 Rissler bale unrollers. End of story!

Feeding 160 head in NY
